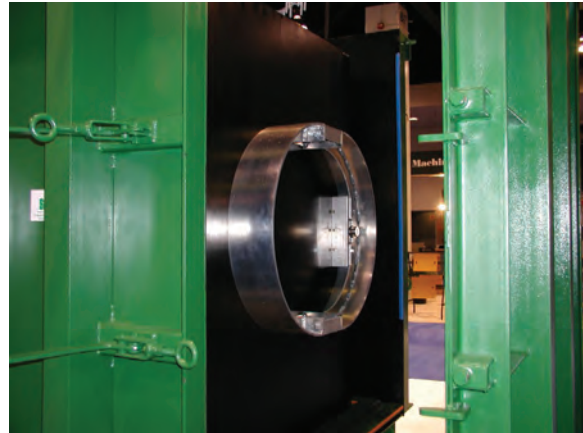

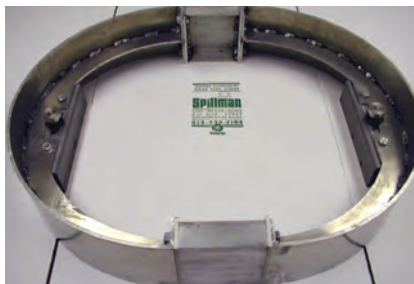
SPILLMAN INTRODUCES EZY-STRYP® ALUMINUM BLOCKOUTS

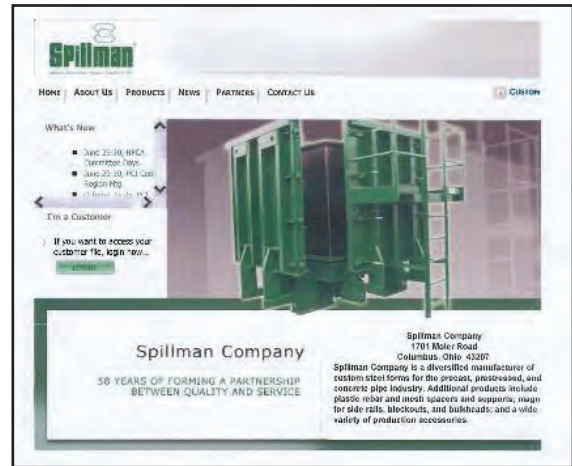

SPILLMAN WEBSITE HAS NEW LOOK

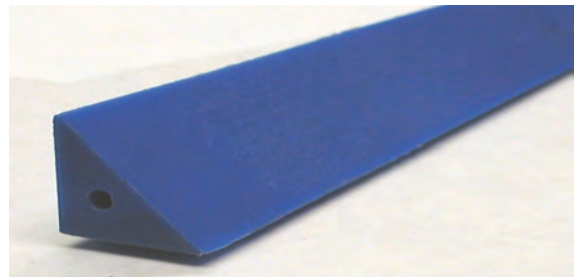
